From 1904 to 1914, the Waveney Hotel was famous for Frank Rice's Zoological Gardens, which featured bears, monkeys and a 'sacred white camel' amongst its menagerie. In 1907, two brown bears escaped, only to be shot and eaten by local villagers!

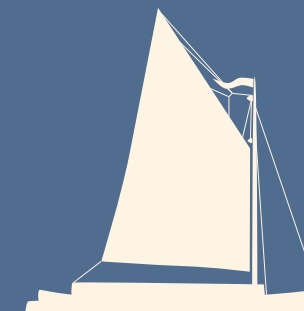

Did You Know?

For centuries, the Burgh St Peter ferry provided the means for South Norfolk villagers to walk or cycle to Lowestoft's fish market, avoiding a 17 mile journey via Beccles bridge.

Today, a new generation of walkers are keen to explore the Broads at a leisurely pace, so in 2012 we revived the ferry to Suffolk. Ferry tickets are available at reception or by calling the ferry man on 07500 571232. The Ternpike ferry service runs all year (subject to tide and weather conditions).
